

## **INVESTMENTS NEEDED**

- Current model takes us through 2024
- \$51.5M of deferred maintenance for parking lots and structures.
- \$3.5M annual routine maintenance
  - Over 21,000 parking spaces
  - Nearly 60 surface lots and 7 parking structures
  - That's nearly 3.5 million square feet of parking space (61 football fields)
- Ongoing investments to support master plan



- Provides additional funding to complete necessary maintenance and upgrades to structures and lots








## SHUTTLE SERVICES


- Year-long shuttle service
  - Regular Tiger Line shuttle 5 a.m. to 8 p.m.
  - 24/7 options to support health care staff
  - Additional support for select locations as needed
- Provided at no additional cost
- Routes throughout campus
  - Current schedule and map available at parking.missouri.edu
  - Track Tiger Line shuttles in real-time online or via app
  - Master Planning group analyzing shuttle needs and making recommendations on alternate routes


