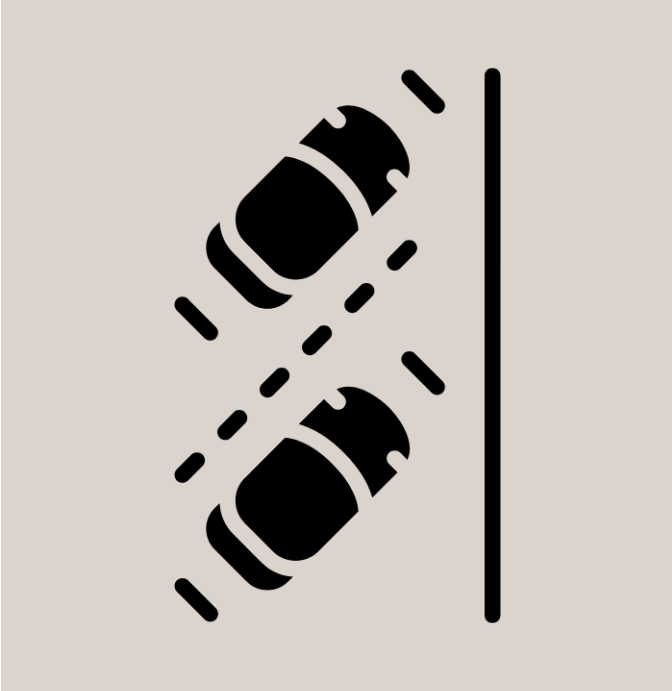
SUPPORTING FUTURE NEEDS

Notes: Tier designations for parking locations remain consistent between pricing groups (e.g., employee pricing, student pricing, etc.). Those with ADA placards will retain the ability to park in any ADA parking spot on campus.

RANGE OF PARKING OPTIONS

- **Parking Permit Program**
- **Pay-Per-Scan**
 - RC9 10 scans = \$15
 - CG1 10 scans = \$15
 - Conley 10 scans = \$30
- **Metered Parking**
- **Visitor Passes**
- **Off Hours**
 - Core campus parking is accessible outside of enforcement hours, from 6 p.m. to 7 a.m. seven days a week, regardless of permit type or allocation.



CAMPUS PARKING ENHANCEMENTS

- Increase Campus Connectivity
- Improve Lighting in Structures and Lots
- Vehicle Assistance
- Focus on Safety – Partnership with University of Missouri Police Department
 - Utilize Safe Walk
 - Increase Cameras
 - MUPD Shuttle Route Patrol

FOUR SHUTTLE LOOP ROUTES

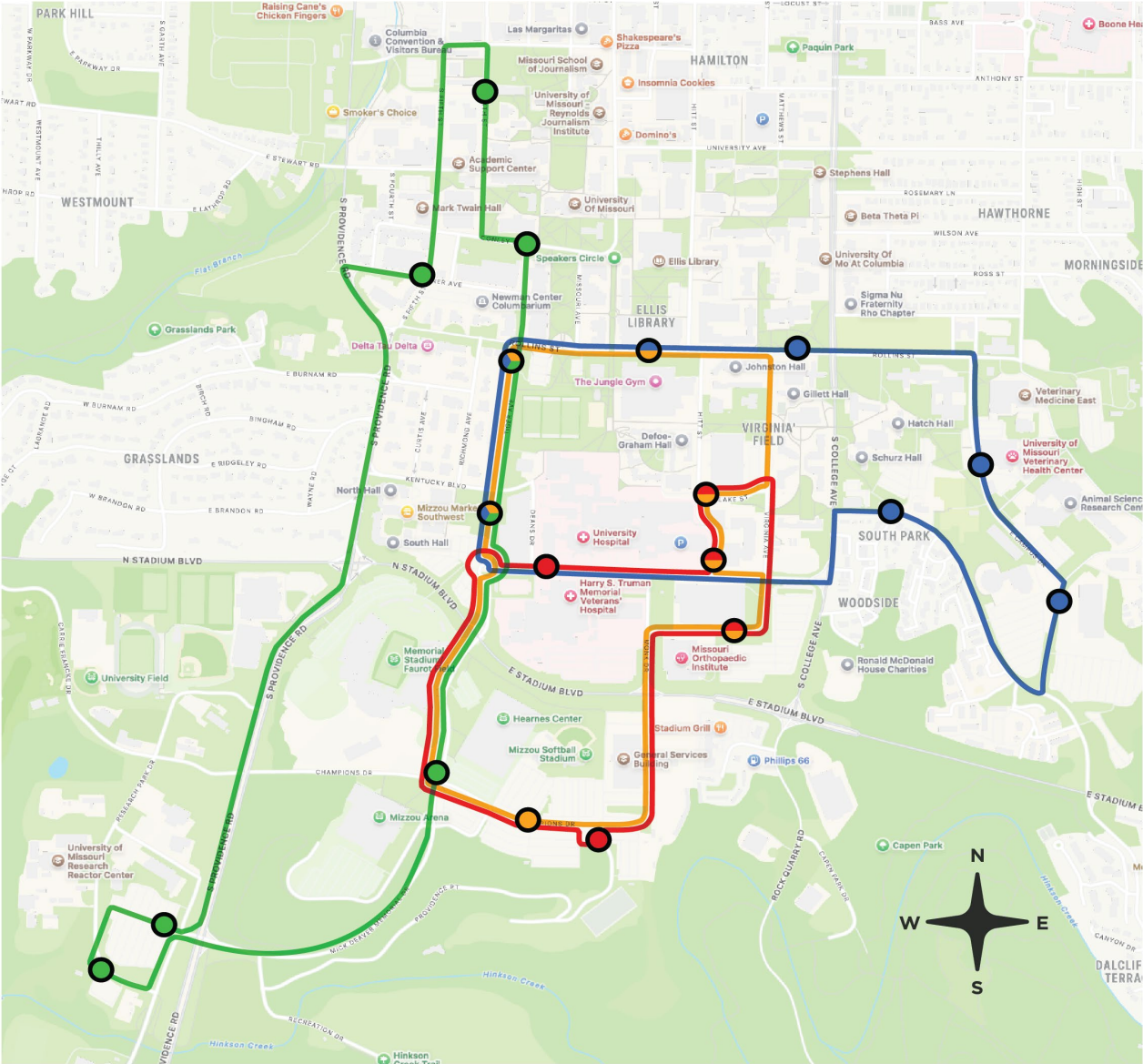
Shuttle Routes

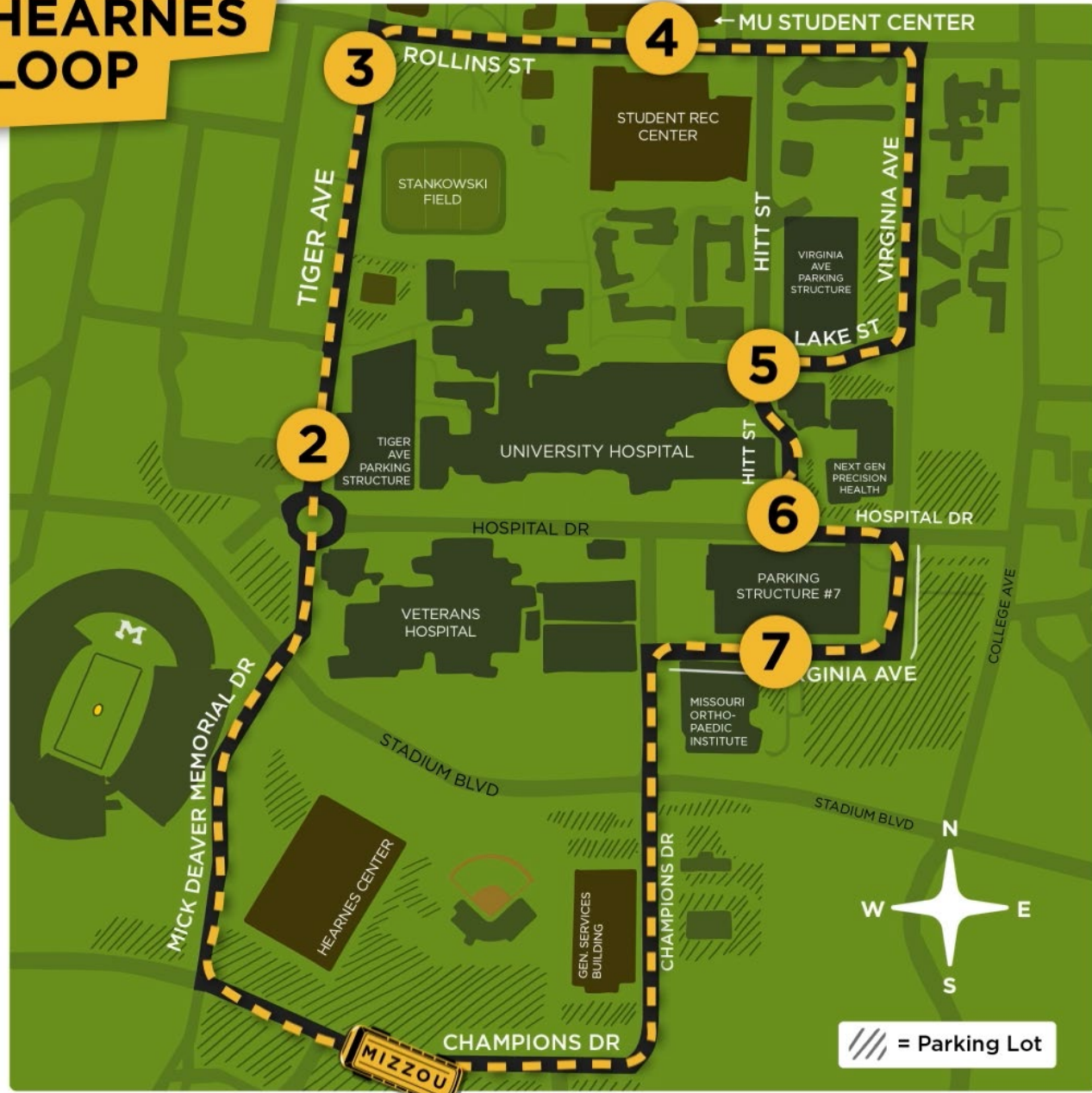
- = MU Health Care Loop

TIMELINE + NEXT STEPS

KEY DATES

SPRING 2025 SEMESTER

- April 7-11 – Shuttle pilot
- April 14 – Election window opens for faculty and staff
- April 28 – Permit assignment confirmation begins for faculty and staff

FALL 2025 SEMESTER

Aug. 1, 2025

- Demand-based parking program goes into effect
- Campuswide shuttle service begins
